## Under this agreement for 2022 Gympie South State School will receive

### This funding will be used to


- Increase the percentage of students in Prep to Year 2 achieving the school benchmark in the English KLA. 2021 saw a 9% increase in student in P-2 receiving C grade or better.
- Ensure all classes identify two marker students per term and articulate the strategies used to help lift their achievement through the use of collaboratively developed learning walls.
- Increase teacher capability and confidence in meeting the needs of students through targeted professional development opportunities aligned to the school improvement agenda.
- Increase the percentage of students achieving a C or higher in English (87% in semester 2, 2021).

### Our initiatives include

- Provide systematic platforms for collaboration and networking to build teacher efficacy in delivering the Australian Curriculum – CASW Regional Project.
- Embed targeted intervention programs (in phonics and reading) for students whom are at risk of not meeting school based benchmarks.
- Targeted Professional Development courses to support the classroom teacher pedagogy and school based programs.
- Continue release time for teachers to engage in the regional premoderation processes, structured data analysis, developing consistency of curriculum and assessment delivery.
- Continue engaging teachers in performance development conversations and feedback processes that focus on the GSSS Reading Framework, Phonics Program and Data Plan; and review of student progress with internal and systemic data processes.

Employing teacher and Speech pathology time to help reduce class numbers, increase support and further develop curriculum knowledge of all staff.	\$98,817
Employing additional teacher aides to assist in the program delivery by providing 1-1 support to identified students.	\$91,467
Provide additional professional development and planning time for teachers in the areas of literacy and numeracy (Planning release time, resources and professional development)	\$71,969
